

Assignment:

1. Think of a topic for your first short paper. For example, the relationship between race and speeding tickets or housing discrimination and poverty.
2. Go to: <http://www.adams.edu/library/databases/databases.php>
3. On the right hand side, under “Nielsen Library” click on “articles.”
4. Towards the center of the page, under “Most popular providers” click on “EBSCOhost” or “Academic Search Complete”.
5. If you are off campus use the username “windy” and the password “weather.”
6. Within EBSCOhost search for at least 5 articles pertaining to your topic. Download the articles to a folder on your computer so that you can access them when you begin writing your first short paper.
7. Return to: <http://www.adams.edu/library/databases/databases.php>
8. On the right hand side, under “Nielsen Library” click on “books.”
9. Under “Materials at ASC” click on “Marmot: ASC Book Catalog.”
10. Search for at least 3 books related to your topic. Note: I recommend going to Nielsen library and checking out the books you find.
11. Finally, open a Word document and create two columns, one labels “articles” and one labeled “books.”
12. Under each column, list the respective articles and books that you found (make sure you include the *full* citation for each article/book).
13. For each article and book include a brief (4 to 5 sentences) description of the article/book in question.
14. Give your document a heading (name, class, date) and bring it to class to turn in. Keep in mind, this assignment is worth 5% of your final grade!
