

Final Presentation

At the end of the semester you are expected to present the observations you make in your final essay to the rest of the class. You may present your work in the way that you are most comfortable with so as long as your presentation clearly and concisely conveys your work to the rest of the class. In your final presentation you should review the core findings from your final essay. You will have 12 minutes to accomplish this. In this time you should be sure to address the main components of your essay, including:

- A brief introduction to the topic
- A description of your research methods (i.e., how did you go about doing your study?)
- An in-depth review of your findings
- A brief conclusion.

Also, please note that you are **REQUIRED** to send me a copy of your final presentation at least 4 days before you actually present. (This may be a PPT, a Prezi, or a detailed outline.) If you do not do this, you will not present and you will automatically receive a 0 for your presentation grade.

Other things to keep in mind:

- Show up early, upload your presentation onto the computer and make sure it is working as intended.
- Practice makes perfect! Practice your presentation frequently in the days leading up to your presentation. Run through it once or twice out loud but also review it in your head from time to time.
- Time your presentation and cut out unnecessary information.
