PODCAST PARA LA PAZ

HABILIDADES (SKILLS)

- Identifying social issues
- Designing media content to draw attention to social issues
- Working in teams in a workshop environment

TAREA (ASSIGNMENT)

The purpose of this assignment is to work with a local NGO, Podcast for Peace, on identifying a social issues within Managua that you would like to draw attention to. In preparation for this assignment, you will visit Podcast for Peace in the Acahualinca neighborhood, which is a working class neighborhood on the edge of Managua's largest trash dump, La Chureca. During your visit you will learn about the neighborhood and the work that Podcast for Peace is currently doing in the area. Following your visit, you will work in teams 3-4 students on identifying a social issue that you would like to focus on in your own short podcast. Over the next two days, you will work with the Podcast for Peace team on designing a podcast script, and ultimately, creating your own short podcast (2-3 minutes). Your Spanish professors will be on hand as well to assist with subtitles and Spanish language content.

Tasks

- Identify a social issue such as
 - Trash collection
 - The importance of social spaces, such as urban parks, on communal wellbeing
 - Food security
 - Price inflation in recent years
 - Migration
 - Discrimination due to gender, race, age, etc.
 - Sustainable development
 - Political apathy
 - Access to stable housing
- Create a short script for your podcast
- Identify what material needs to be gathered
 - Video clips
 - Photos
 - Facts such as migration rates, inflation rates, or the percentage of children without access to stable housing
- Identify who will do each task
 - Divide tasks among team
- Edit a short podcast
 - Review and make necessary edits
