TAREA (ASSIGNMENT)

Interview (RMES):

While in El Campo you had the opportunity to become familiar with using digital applications to record an interview. On the Caribbean Coast you are required to prepare and record another interview using a digital tool of your choice. You may conduct the interview in your free time at any point during the excursion. The subject of your interview should address issues germane to life on the Caribbean Coast. Be sure to put some thought into the questions you prepare for your interview prior to leaving for Bluefields, so that when you arrive you don't have to adjust your interview script too much. As in the campo, for this assignment, you should record your interview, so that upon your return to Managua you can create a transcription. The following are potential topics for interviews:

- Racial and ethnic relations in Bluefields
- Bilingual education on the Caribbean Coast
- The national autonomy law in practice
- Drug trafficking and its effects on local communities
- Land wars and mestizo settlement in autonomous regions
- Deforestation
- The effects of tourism on local communities
- Memories of Bluefields prior to the hurricane
- The history of music on the coast

In addition, you should transcribe your interview and include analytical notes in the margins or by bracketing in-between transcriptions. Be sure to include the full name and age of your interviewee, as well as the time, place and subject of your interview. Please turn in both your interview file and transcription via e-mail.
