TAREA (ASSIGNMENT)

During your time in Nicaragua you have had the privilege of seeing life through the lens of people who live and work in La Maximo Jerez. You have also had the opportunity to read *Life is Hard*, which documents Roger Lancaster's experience in La Maximo nearly three decades ago. This is your chance to update *Life is Hard* with a new interview. To this end, you should conduct an *entrevista* with someone from La Maximo about a subject related to life in the neighborhood. Be sure to record your interview. The following themes serve as examples to get you thinking:

- Social networks
- Remittances and immigration
- Life in La Maximo with Internet
- Political tendencies of children who grew up in Sandanista households
- The impact of SIT on the neighborhood
- Life before and after the Sandanistas return to power

In addition, you should transcribe your interview and include analytical notes in the margins or by bracketing in-between transcriptions. Be sure to include the full name and age of your interviewee, as well as the time, place and subject of your interview. Please turn in both your interview and transcription via e-mail.
